The Stock Horse of Texas (SHOT) is an association which was started by a state-wide planning group in the early 1990s and incorporated in 1998. Its purpose is education for western horse enthusiasts to ride and train an all-around western stock horse that can be ridden on the ranch, in the ring or down the road. SHOT's goal is to teach rider knowledge and skills to maximize horse trainability, performance and safety by offering affordable, fun and standardized western stock horse riding clinics and competitions.

## SHOT CLINICS AND SHOWS

Shot Clinics and Shows encompass all of what the SHOT organization is about – educating horsemen and women on how to train and develop their own horse and then provide a forum to test their horse in a show.

**ABILENE** – The Abilene Clinic on Feb. 28 and March 1 featured Robert Chown of Gainesville, TX and Buddy Fisher of Abilene, TX. This two day clinic drew 60 participants. The Show held on March 2 had 82 entries

**FT WORTH** – The Ft Worth Clinic and Show on Mach 24, 25 and 26 featured a two day show on Saturday and Sunday and had the largest number of entries we have had at a SHOT show – 157.
